BILL MARTIN-VISCOUNT

A very stunning technical pas de deux performed only in Moscow by the Stanislovsky-Demirovich Ballet and London's Festival Ballet in England. The ballet was originally produced in 1844 by Jules Perrot in London and re-edited by Marius Petipa in Russia in 1886. For this version Petipa was assisted by composer Drigo in re-editing the Pugni score.

The Pas de Deux was produced for Mr. Martin-Viscount in Moscow but variations and code were choreographed by himself. This Pas de Deux is from the last act of the full length ballet "Esmeralda."

Arnold Haskell, noted British ballet authority, recalled that the dance "does something that I cannot remember ever having done before. It uses an acrobatic technique of amazing difficulty to convey with wonderful musicianship a deep lyrical emotion suggesting the impression of ice turning to water after a cold Russian winter."

This production of "Spring Waters" was mounted for Mr. Martin-Viscount by Asaf Messerer in Moscow in 1966 when he was with the Bolshoi Ballet training and coaching with the highly esteemed Alexei Yermolayev.
